



SCADA Scholarship for Automotive Excellence FALL 2017

Scholarship Guidelines and Process

The South Carolina Automobile Dealers Association and its Board of Directors are pleased to award scholarships to deserving students pursuing an education and career in automotive technology. The SCADA Dealer Services and Education Committee will directly oversee selecting and awarding the scholarships to the deserving individuals.

The following guidelines have been established for the SCADA Scholarship for Automotive Excellence for the 2017 enrollment year:

- The applicant must be a resident of South Carolina with plans to attend a college or technical school in the fall of 2017.
- The applicant should be seeking enrollment in an Automotive Technology degree program at a South Carolina or qualifying out of state college of their choice. Unless gainfully employed, the applicant should maintain a full time student status.
- Preference will be given to applicants who show an interest and desire to work for a South Carolina Dealership upon completion of their degree program.
- Applicants must complete and return the application packet including the student background sheets, the recommendation form and transcripts no later than April 28, 2017.
- The SCADA Dealer Services and Education Committee will review the applications and determine the recipients and the total amounts to be awarded.
- Award recipients or students wishing to be awarded consecutive years must reapply each year with complete application materials. Those reapplying must be in good standing at their college and on track to graduate.
- Dependents of Dealers are not eligible to apply.
- All scholarship awards will be paid directly to the institution and be credited towards the student's account. Funds may be used towards tuition, fees, books, tools and other eligible education expenses.
